




EN Press to turn on. Press and hold to turn off.

Creating an instrument


EN Select "Add Instrument", choose the type, the number of strings and name it.


EN Select an instrument from the list.


EN Place Roadie on the peg starting with the lowest note.

DE Setze die Motorkurbel des Roadie an den Stimmwirbel (Mechanik), beginne mit der Saite mit dem tiefsten Ton.






- **EN** When the string is tuned, Roadie will vibrate, flash a light and beep. Move on to the next string.


Re-stringing with Roadie Bass

EN Return to the main menu and select Wind/Unwind.




